The Nomination Committee for Thule Group AB intends to propose Bengt Baron as new chairman of the board in connection with the Annual General Meeting 2018

The Nomination Committee of Thule Group AB intends to, in connection with the the Annual General Meeting in April 2018, propose Bengt Baron to succeed current chairman of the board Stefan Jacobsson, who has declined re-election. Bengt Baron has been a member of the Board of Directors of Thule Group since 2011.

In order for the Nomination Committee to be able to carry out an effective nomination work, the Nomination Committee has decided to present the proposal for chairman of the board that the Nomination Committee intends to propose in connection with the Annual General Meeting on April 25, 2018.
